Rules: I.S.S.F. and Pistol Australia rules will be followed as closely as practicable. **Local range rules will apply**, including competitors must not be in bays while range staff are down range, local target configurations and the use of safety flags.

Entries: Entries will be accepted in order of receipt up to range capacity* by the closing date, Wednesday 19th of April 2025. Competitors will be required to record their handgun license and handgun serial numbers on the appropriate participation sheets at the Open.

Entry Fees: \$15.00 per event to accompany entry form. Entries will not be accepted without entry fees. Direct deposits using your name as a reference can be made to YPC Inc., BSB: 083-321 Account: 131618601 **No Payment – No Entry**

Late Entries: Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Organizing Secretary.

Licenses and ID Cards: It is a condition of entry that all competitors have a current Victorian Handgun License or equivalent license issued under another state/territory, and wear a V.A.P.A. ID card with a current financial sticker attached. Interstate competitors must provide proof of current affiliation with Pistol Australia.

Squadding: All competitors will be advised of their squadding via email (preferably). Squadding time is the commencement of the match. Preparation time is before this. Please note that for 10m Air Pistol and 50m Pistol events, competitors <u>must</u> be on the line 15 minutes prior to the commencement time of the match.

Trophies: Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each grade of each event. There will also be a Men's 5 Match Aggregate, a Women's 3 Match Aggregate (Air, 25m Pistol, Standard) and a Junior 2 Match Aggregate (Air, 25m Pistol).

This Year we will also be offering an option to opt in or out of receiving a placing medal

Catering: Light meals and snacks available both days. Hot and cold drinks and a fully licensed bar also available.

Camping: Unfortunately, it is a condition of our lease that camping is NOT permitted on the range.
